

Prayer Guide

1. Pray that the person will be given spiritual sight to see what they are currently blinded to. “The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.” (2 Corinthians 4:4) “But whenever anyone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.” (2 Corinthians 3:16)
2. Pray that the light of God’s truth will permeate the spiritual darkness of the person’s life. “The path of the righteous is like the morning sun, shining ever brighter till the full light of day. But the way of the wicked is like deep darkness; they do not know what makes them stumble. (Proverbs 4:18-19) For what we preach is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, and ourselves as your servants for Jesus’ sake. For God, who said, “Let light shine out of darkness,” made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God’s glory displayed in the face of Christ.” (2 Corinthians 4:5-6)
3. Pray that the Holy Spirit will bring conviction upon the hearts of the person so they will be prompted to seek God. “When he comes, he will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment: about sin, because people do not believe in me; about righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; and about judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned.” (John 16:8-11)
4. Pray that God will reveal Himself to the person in an undeniable way. “No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day.” John 6:44
5. Pray that the person would have a repentant heart. “Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to knowledge of the truth, and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will.” (2 Timothy 2:25-26)
